Good to Have Items Good to have: Sunscreen and thermal protective clothing appropriate for the water temperature • Snacks and water • Compass, Portable Marine Radio Be sure to: Secure loose items • Protect moisture-sensitive items in waterproof containers **Inspect:** Board for cracks Condition of sail or wing

Brief Passengers:

- Wear Lifejacket / PFD
- Duties including Keeping Watch
- Location/Use of Safety Gear

On Water:

Watch for:

- Hazards / Other Boats
- Cloud, Wind / Wave Changes

If a portable marine radio is available, check periodically for updated marine weather forecasts.

Watch for hazards, approaching storms and wakes from other boats
