How to Make a Homemade Bailer





Materials:

- Plastic detergent or bleach bottle (at least 750 ml size)
- Scissors
- X-ACTO Knife
- Marker
- Glue Ultra Adhesive



Step One:

Completely rinse the bottle to remove any residual content.



Step Two

Only do if Removing Bottom:

Using ultra adhesive glue, outline the threads within the cap, then put the cap back on and tighten.

Step Three:

Take a marker, and mark the area on the bottom or around the top of the bottle that is to be cut.





Step Four:

With an X-ACTO knife, make an initial slit along the line, and then using scissors finish cutting along the same line until the bottom or top is fully detached.

Ensure that the opening is sufficiently sized to allow the water to fill the container quickly.

Flexible plastic bottles are preferred because they can mold themselves to conform to either flat, or curved surfaces to more effectively expel the water.
